The Questionnaire must be completed in its entirety in Microsoft® Word or PDF format and returned by email to PA-JudicialSelectionApplication@pa.gov, no later than **5 PM, Eastern Standard Time, Monday, June 11, 2018**.

Applicants will be thoroughly screened and contacted for interviews as appropriate.
