Superior Court of Pennsylvania Commonwealth Court of Pennsylvania

As a result of the November 2015 judicial elections and announced or anticipated retirements, there will be several vacancies on the Superior Court of Pennsylvania and the Commonwealth Court of Pennsylvania. Governor Tom Wolf invites all persons interested in being considered for interim appointments to the position of Judge on either of these Courts to obtain and submit an application (“Questionnaire for Pennsylvania’s Judicial Applicants”) that can be found in the **Application** section below.

The Questionnaire must be completed in its entirety in Microsoft® Word or PDF format and returned by email to PA-JudicialSelectionApplication@pa.gov, no later than **5 PM, Eastern Standard Time, Friday, February 5, 2016**. Please indicate whether you are applying for the Superior Court, the Commonwealth Court, or both. Applicants will be contacted thereafter as appropriate to arrange for interviews.

In accordance with the Governor’s commitment to diversity and inclusion, qualified women, members of minority groups, veterans, and persons with disabilities are encouraged to submit applications. *Please note that all applicants interested in being considered for an interim appointment must complete this process, regardless of whether they have participated in previous judicial selection processes.*
