ANNOUNCEMENT OF JUDICIAL VACANCY

Supreme Court of Pennsylvania

Governor Tom Wolf invites all persons interested in being considered for an interim appointment to the position of Justice on the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania to obtain and submit an application (“Questionnaire for Judicial Nominees to the Supreme Court”) that can be found in the **Application** section below.

The Questionnaire must be completed in its entirety in Microsoft® Word or PDF format and returned by email to SUPREME-JudicialSelectionApplication@pa.gov, as soon as possible. Applicants will be contacted thereafter as appropriate to arrange for interviews.

In accordance with the Governor’s commitment to diversity and inclusion, qualified women, members of minority groups, veterans, and persons with disabilities are encouraged to submit applications. *Please note that all applicants interested in being considered for an interim appointment must complete this process, regardless of whether they have participated in previous judicial selection processes.*
