The Pennsylvania Governor's Office of General Counsel (OGC) seeks an attorney who can advise the Department of Health (DOH) with respect to general legal issues in support of various DOH programs, including, but not limited to, the Bureau of Health Statistics and Registries, Bureau of Laboratories, Division of Home Health, and other areas. In accordance with OGC policy, a hybrid remote/in-office schedule of three days onsite in Harrisburg may also be available at the General Counsel's discretion. The position will be filled at the Attorney 1 or 2 level, dependent on experience and is an excellent opportunity for an attorney interested in developing expertise in the laws and processes applicable to Commonwealth government.

An ideal candidate will have familiarity with or an interest in developing expertise in the laws and processes applicable to Commonwealth government. The successful candidate will work closely with DOH's senior level attorneys in the handling of general legal matters which may include legal opinions, administrative litigation, regulatory matters, and entry-level procurement matters.

The successful candidate will assist senior level attorneys in advising DOH programs with respect to applicable state and federal laws. Additionally, this attorney will be expected to represent DOH in administrative hearings before the Department of State and, if needed, the appellate courts. Counsel will also need to review and respond to records requests and subpoenas.

This position requires excellent written and oral communication skills, attention to detail, excellent interpersonal skills, and the ability to foster trust and respect, including creating friendly and collaborative working relationships with colleagues and clients.

The Governor's Office of General Counsel provides efficient, responsive legal services to the Commonwealth, the Governor, members of his cabinet and more than 30 executive branch agencies, including DOH, that conducts the business of the Commonwealth.
