The position is will be classified as either an Attorney 1, 2, or 3, depending on the level of relevant experience possessed by the successful candidate. While based in Harrisburg, this position is eligible for a hybrid remote/in-office schedule of three days per week onsite at the discretion of the General Counsel.

The OA, Office of Chief Counsel provides efficient, responsive legal services to agencies under the Governor's jurisdiction on legal matters related to labor, employment, and human relations matters. A minimum of two (2) years of experience in labor and employment matters, preferably in the public sector, is preferred.

The successful candidate will have excellent written and oral communication skills, as well as exceptional research abilities. The candidate will have an ability to handle a variety of legal matters both independently and as part of a team, as well as the ability to interact within both the greater legal community and a governmental organization. The candidate must have an interest in and preferred experience with litigation, particularly in the labor and employment area, as well as experience with equal employment opportunity matters. Experience with benefit plans would be helpful. Excellent interpersonal skills, including the ability to foster trust and respect and to create friendly and collaborative working relationships with internal Commonwealth clients, are a must.

The candidate must have a Juris Doctor degree from an ABA-accredited law school and be a member in good standing with the Pennsylvania Bar.
