#### PART I.

This RFP was issued pursuant to Executive Order 2015-2 dated January 20, 2015, and in accordance with Section 518 of the Commonwealth Procurement Code, 62 Pa.C.S. § 518, and Part III Chapter 8 of the Department of General Services (DGS) Procurement Handbook.

#### PART II.

- A. PUBLIC NOTICE: Public notice of the RFP was posted on both the DGS website and the Office of General Counsel's website on **September 28, 2022.**
- B. EVALUATION COMMITTEE: An evaluation committee was established consisting of agency representatives from the Department of General Services, Department of Human Services, Pennsylvania State Police, Department of Transportation, Department of State, Department of Environmental Protection and the Governor's Office of General Counsel.
- C. ADDENDA TO THE RFP: Potential offerors were given the opportunity in accordance with Section I-9 of the RFP to submit questions concerning the procurement to the Issuing Office. The official responses to the questions were incorporated into the RFP by addenda per Section I-10 of the RFP.

#### PART III.

- A. CRITERIA: The relative importance of the major evaluation criteria established prior to opening the proposals consisted of technical 100% and 100 law firm diversity bonus points.
- B. PROPOSALS: A total of twenty-seven (27) proposals were received on or before the due date of October 28, 2022. No proposals were received late.

#### C. RESULTS:

- 1. The evaluation committee reported the following results of its evaluation to the Issuing Office:
- As indicated in the Initial Scoring, all of the offeror's technical submittals received at least 75% of the available technical points required in order to be eligible to be considered for award.
- 3. Six (6) offerors failed to meet the SDB/VBE participation goals set forth in this RFP and were therefore rejected as non-responsive.
- 4. Representatives from the Department of General Services and Governor's Office of General Counsel evaluated and scored the law firm diversity submittals and combined the technical scores and law firm diversity scores.

6. SMALL DIVERSE BUSINESS/VETERAN BUSINESS ENTERPRISE COMMITMENTS:

For purposes of this RFP, Small Diverse Business (SDB) and Veteran Business Enterprise (VBE) participation goals were established as 16% for SDB and 3% for VBE. All of the firms either agreed to meet or exceed the SDB and VBE participation goals established for this RFP. The Axelrod Firm, P.C. and Wong Fleming, P.C. are self-performing the SDB portion of this RFP as DGS-verified SDBs.

This recommendation selection is based upon the results of the evaluation and review of the proposals as summarized above. The term of the contracts will be one year with two (2) additional one (1) year renewals. The Governor's Office of General Counsel, will allocate the legal services set forth in the resulting contracts among the selected law firms.
